THE 24TH DOCNET SYMPOSIUM

Advances in generative artificial intelligence are reshaping creative practice and challenging long-held ideas about art, originality, and authorship. As machines compose music, create images, and produce texts, the boundaries between human and artificial creativity are becoming increasingly difficult to define. What qualifies as art? Who can claim authorship? And what, if anything, remains uniquely human?

This year's DocNet Symposium brings together leading voices from the arts, science, law, and industry to examine how artificial intelligence is transforming art and culture. From emerging forms of collaboration between humans and machines to pressing ethical and legal questions, the symposium explores whether AI will enrich human creativity, fundamentally redefine it, or increasingly take its place.
